- Develops and implements strategies that improve the overall process from initial job handoff to production and completion.
- Develops processes to ensure all project/product details are communicated effectively and efficiently from estimator to engineering to production.
- Manages resources such as the workload schedule of the Design Engineers and the programming schedule to ensure all deadlines are met.
- Communicates with the management team any potential issues and delays so action can be taken to resolve problems as a team.
- · Prioritizes and assigns workloads based on customer schedules.
- Allocates production paperwork to the appropriate Design Engineers (DE).
- Trains employees in the programming and material ordering processes including Core Drill.
- Coordinates any approved design changes to the entire Design Staff.
- Monitors departmental workload by collecting and analyzing weekly hours and a Saturday schedule.

   Responsibilities include interviewing, hiring, and training employees; planning, assigning, and directing work; appraising performance; rewarding and disciplining employees; addressing complaints and resolving problems.
